

Do you qualify for an Initial School Business Official Authorization?

Here are the options within lowa code for qualifying for an Initial Authorization.

- You must have a job offer from an lowa school district.
- Educational qualifications- One of the options below:
 - A Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree in Business or Accounting
 - An Associates of Arts Degree or Associates of Science in Business or Accounting
 - 60 college credits of Business-related courses.
- You must have a minimum of 6 credits of accounting for the Temporary Initial SBO Authorization. 9 credits of accounting are required for the Initial SBO Authorization.
 - ➤ The Initial School Business Official Authorization is valid for 2 years, during which you will complete a 1 year mentor program through the lowa School Business Institute.
 - The Temporary Initial School Business Official Authorization is valid for 1 year, during which you will need to complete the accounting credits to reach the 9-credit threshold while also beginning your year in the mentoring program and completing year 1 requirements through the lowa School Business Institute.
